1. Budget:
 - Vote to approve needed tonight. The expenses are higher than income because we fundraised for the raincoats last year. Noel Caryl moved to approved. Joe Muharsky seconds. Motion carried.
 2. Fundraisers planned for the year: Concession stand sales will come next year. \$220 for lunchboxes.
 - a. Butter Braids: Will look a little different this year as we have a new rep. Stuck with the same delivery time as they are in the process of moving to Washington State. What they are selling cannot be changed and options cannot be altered. There will be GF options like cookies. No Puffins this year. **Dates:** Forms to go out before the Thanksgiving holiday.  - c. Grant chair: Ref grant through October 20th.
