

Uniforms

Cedarcrest Band Boosters Chair

Position Description

Lead role in ensuring the students have clean and appropriate fitting uniforms during the current school year. Additional volunteers may be recruited as needed.

Requirements

The following list provides the general expectation for this position:

- Assign uniforms (tops, ascots, bibbers)
- Assign a raincoat
- Monitor condition, Repair as needed
- Maintain inventory
- Recommend replacements, if necessary
- Ensure all are clean at the conclusion of the season or prior to extended storage.
- Confirm each student has marching shoes. Provide sizes to Band Director to place order.

Timeframe

Responsibilities for this role begin in August, during band camp, with student measurements. The primary period of time this role is from late August through November. The role will continue through the remainder of the school year to support a spring trip or other activity that involves the uniforms.

Additional Information and Resources

When assigning uniforms returning students should try on their uniform from the prior year to check the fit. Reassign a different size as needed. Preferably this begins with the Seniors. Freshmen or new students will need to have a uniform assigned.

New students will need to have shoes ordered. The first pair of shoes for a student is covered by the band fee. Returning students should be asked if they need to order replacement shoes. The cost for purchasing replacement marching shoes is the responsibility of each student and is not covered by the band fee. Payment for shoes should be handled directly by the Band Director.

Uniforms, including the raincoat, are stored in garment bags and are labeled with each student's name. Replacement bags and/or hangers may need to be replaced during the year.
